Research Promotion

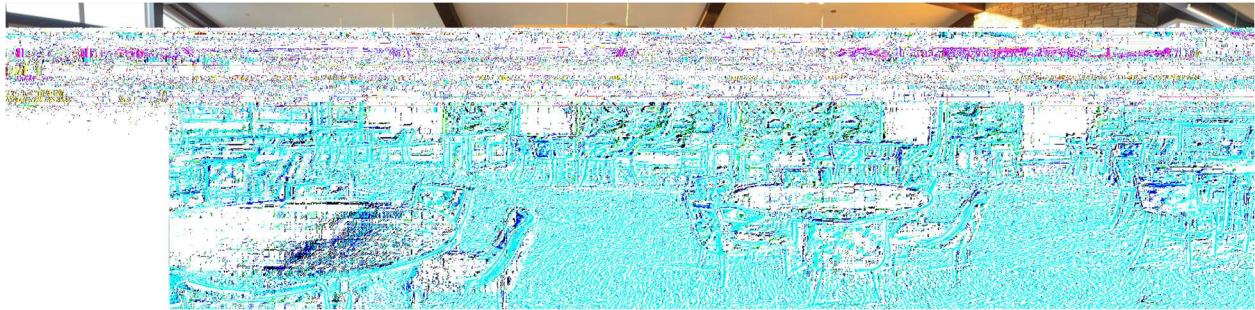

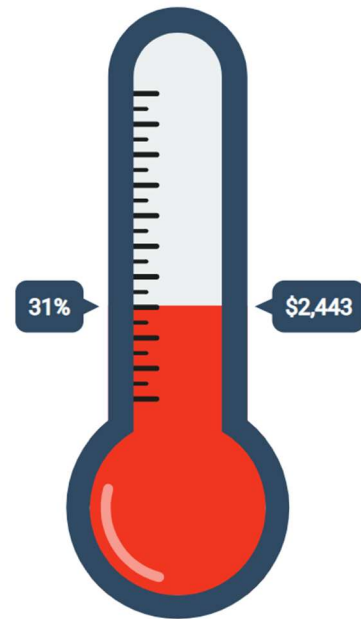
