The board is excited about our site tour to the new YWCA Centre in the heart of Regina. Please review the PPE requirements in the meeting flyer prior to attending.

The project is an 85,000 ft² building that is situated in the Cathedral area of Regina. The name, Kikakihtânaw, translates to “we will all succeed” and the centre is scheduled to open September 2024. The Centre will have 40 emergency shelter spaces, 68 affordable housing units, two childcare centres, a multi-purpose community space, commercial kitchen and coffee shop. It will also serve as a year-round healing lodge and ceremony site.
