



The event raised a total of \$600 for ASHRAE Research. Thank you to everyone who generously donated prizes and thank you to everyone who bought tickets!

Each individual entrant will pay a fee of \$20.00 cash plus contribute a 6-pack regular sized cans, or a 4-pack of tall cans of beer/cider.

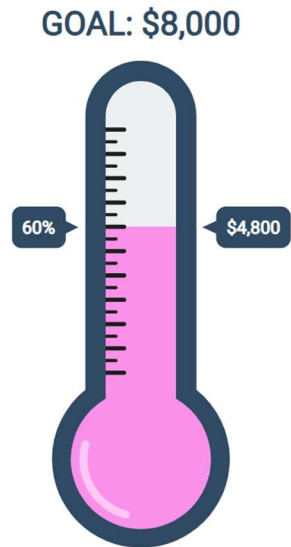
The beer must be bottled and sealed commercially (not homemade).
